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PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for records relating to the impugned circular issued by the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent dated 12.02.2013 from the files of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent and quash the same and consequently direct the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent Management to constitute a fresh Review Departmental Promotion Committee, including representatives from the petitioner Association in the said RDPC in order to strictly follow DOPT/DPE guidelines in OM No.36012/2/96 – Estt (Res) dated 02.07.1992 and other relevant guidelines in the matter of granting promotions to SC/STs, and to complete the review within three months and thereafter release the promotion orders based on the new RDPC report to the affected employees including the SC/STs by granting due seniority and monitory benefits from the date they were eligible for such promotion.
