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Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ of habeas corpus to call for the entire records relating to the petitioner's husband detention under Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 vide detention order dated 12.01.2023 on the file of the second respondent herein made in proceedings Memo No.23/BCDFGISSSV/2023, quash the same as illegal and consequently, direct the respondents herein to produce the petitioner's husband namely, Gopinathan, son of Narayanan, aged 49 years before this Hon'ble High Court and set the petitioner's husband at liberty from detention, now the petitioner's husband detained at Central Prison, Puzhal, Chennai.
