Prayer in W.P.No.7300 of 2004: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the fifth respondent herein to forthwith enquire into the manner in which tenders are floated and awarded by respondents 1 and 2 herein in respect of the works in North West Sub Division of Public Works Department, Chepauk, Chennai 600005 for the past 2 years and the abuse of official position by respondents 3 and 4 herein for illegal gratification and personal gains in the award of contracts in the said Sub Division and take appropriate action on the same.
