This application has been filed to implead the respondents 4 to 10 as respondents.

The application has been filed by the applicant on the ground that the respondents 4 to 10 are presently interested in the subject property. In so far as the respondents 4 to 8, there is no objection for allowing this impleading petition. However the other respondent no.9, who is the legal heir of the respondents 1 and 2, opposed the said application on the ground that he is the legal heir as an adopted daughter. On this score, he has opposed the application for impleading the other respondents in the second appeal. The

suit is for specific performance of agreement of sale at the instance of the

plaintiff / appellant. Therefore these interse disputes, need not be decided at the present stage. Hearing all the parties in the second appeal would suffice and the interests of all the parties would stand protected. Hence the C.M.P. No.3110 of 2021 is ordered.
