2. Today, when the matter taken up for hearing, both the petitioner along with his counsel and learned Government Advocate appeared. The learned Government Advocate appearing for respondents would submit that already entire retirement benefits along with interest was received by the petitioner and to that effect, he produced the copy of stamped receipt dated

Considering the fact that already entire terminal benefits were settled to the petitioner, this Writ Petition is closed with liberty to approach the concerned Consumer Forum for appropriate remedy. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
