If the cost is paid on or before 14.06.2023 and the affidavit of service is filed, this Petition stands allowed and the Registry is directed to number the main Appeal. If the cost is not paid and the affidavit of service is not filed on or before 14.06.2023, this C.M.P. stands dismissed without any reference to this Court.
