This petition is filed under Section 378(4) Cr.P.C, to grant special leave to file an appeal against the order dated 15.12.2022 made in C.C. No.50 of 2020 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court (Magistrate Level), Tiruvannamalai.

2. Mr.N. Palanikumar, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that though the respondent/accused admitted his signature on the cheque, the trial court had acquitted the accused without considering the presumptions under Sections 118 and 139 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

3. In the circumstances, there are some arguable points in the present appeal and accordingly, special leave is granted.
