This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. **Mrs.Ramya V.Rao**, learned counsel appeared for the appellants. After mutual discussion and negotiation between both parties they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:



TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

WEB COPY This is an appeal filed by the claimants. The trial Court has awarded a sum of Rs.6,50,704/- along with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum. After due deliberation and consultation, both parties have agreed for enhancement of the award amount by a sum of Rs.3,40,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Forty Thousand only) in full quit, over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal as compensation.

2. The award amount of Rs.6,50,704/- along with interest at 7.5% per annum and the additional sum of Rs.3,40,000/- shall be deposited within a period of eight weeks from today. The claimants will be entitled to withdraw the sum on proper identification and verification in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition.

3. In view of the same, the Civil Miscellaneous Appeal stands disposed off. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition/s is/are closed, if any.
