COMMON ORDER

Considering the said submissions made by the learned Additional Government Pleader, this Court directs the 3rd respondent herein to decide the respective revisions filed by the petitioners before the 3rd respondent on 08.10.2020 and pass orders thereon on merits and in accordance with law after giving an opportunity of being heard to the petitioners as well as the rival claimants if any, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, these writ petitions are disposed of. No costs.
