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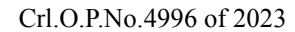

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking direction to the learned District Sessions Judge Villupuram, Special Judge for Prevention of SC/ST Atrocities to consider the bail application on the same day in connection with S.C.No.18 of 2016 before the Special Judge for Prevention of SC/ST Atrocities Act – Villupuram in Crime No.329 of 2015 on the file of the 2nd respondent police on their surrender.

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of the Parliament against innocent persons, there shall be a direction to the learned District Sessions Judge Villupuram, Special Judge for Prevention of SC/ST Atrocities to consider the petitioners' bail application, preferably on the same day of their surrender in connection with S.C.No.18 of 2016 before the Special Judge for Prevention of SC/ST Atrocities Act – Villupuram in Crime No.329 of 2015 registered for the offence under Sections 147, 148, 341, 323, 324, 506(ii), 307, 438 of IPC and Section 3(2)(r) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 on the file of the second respondent and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity to the victims under Section 15-A of the SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989. The petitioners shall surrender before the concerned Jurisdictional Court, within a period of fifteen days from the date of the receipt of a copy of this Order.

3. It is needless to say that the Court below while disposing the bail petition shall look into the gravity of the offence, previous antecedents of the petitioners and pass orders. Mere direction issued by this Court to consider the bail petition on the same day, does not amount to consider it



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favourably.

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4. In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
