2.It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is running a business of Massage Parlour, SPA, Beauty Parlour in the name and style of “Rainbow Ayurvedic Massage Centre”. He would further submitted that the petitioner has made a representation dated 10.02.2023 to the respondents seeking for the issuance of “No Objection Certificate” to run the said business and the same is not considered by the respondents.
