ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to grant permission to conduct cultural Programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Arulmigu Sri Mariamman Kovil Thiruvizha, Chinnakuttai Valavu, Mallikuttai Village, Omalur Taluk, Salem District on 10.03.2023, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 18.02.2023.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of Arulmigu Sri Mariamman Kovil Thiruvizha, Chinnakuttai Valavu, Mallikuttai Village, Omalur Taluk, Salem District on 10.03.2023, the petitioner has sent a representation, dated 18.02.2023 to the respondent Police. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) appearing for the respondents submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 18.02.2023 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.
