ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed to the 1st respondent to issue a No Objection certificate to the petitioner to run a SPA i.e. Cross relaxation massage in the name and style of “Purple Ayurvedic Spa” Door No. 4/533, R.S.Road, Dharmapuri, Dharmapuri District by passing orders on the petitioner's representation dated 17.02.2023.
