2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of Dance Programme on 21.02.2023 and 22.02.2023 between 7.00 P.M. to 10.00 P.M. at Kommampattu Village, Uthangarai Taluk, Krishnagiri District, the petitioner has sent a representation, dated 17.02.2023 to the respondent Police. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 17.02.2023 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.
