Prayer:- Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, declaring the entire acquisition proceedings initiated by the 1st Respondent under the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 issued in Memo No. 83834-L.A II/62-1 Industries, Labour and Co-operation dated 15.06.1962 and in Memo No. 83834-LA I/62 Industries, Labour and Co-operation dated 16.06.1962, published in the Government Gazette on 20.06.1962 in respect of the lands of an extent of acre 5.16 cents comprised in S.No. 70/1, an extent of acre 2.27 cents comprised in S.No. 73/2 and an extent of acre 5.68 cents comprised in S.No. 77, totally admeasuring acre 13.11 cents, situated in Porur Village, Maduravoyal Taluk, Chennai District, (Previously Tiruvallur District) belonging to the petitioner, become lapsed, by virtue of operation of the provisions contained in Section 24(2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Re-Settlement Act, (Act 30/2013).
