This petition is filed under Section 378(4) Cr.P.C, to grant leave to file an appeal against the judgment dated 22.12.2022 in STC No.624/2017 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate (Fast Track) Court No.II, Erode.

2. Mr. J. Titus Enock, learned counsel for the petitioner contended that though the respondent/accused admitted her signature on the cheque, the trial court had acquitted the accused without considering the presumptions under Sections 118 and 139 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

3. In the circumstances, there are some arguable points in the present appeal and accordingly, leave is granted.



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4. Registry is directed to number the Criminal Appeal, if it is otherwise in order, and list the matter for admission in the usual course.
