Today, when these matters were taken up for hearing, Mr.R.Neelakandan, learned Additional Advocate General, producing a copy of G.O. (Ms.) No.44, Environment, Climate Change and Forests (FR.2(i)) Department dated 03.03.2023, submitted that the services of the employees have been regularised, as a special case, and that the monetary benefits would be extended from the date of completion of ten years.

2 In a riposte, the learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that only sanction has been accorded for allowing the monetary benefits from the date of completion of ten years, *vide* the aforesaid Government Order, and that the monetary benefits have not yet been paid to the petitioners.



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3 Having regard to the submissions made on either side, this Court directs the Government to release the monetary benefits from the date of completion of ten years, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. We make it clear that in case, the monetary benefits are not paid to the petitioners within a period of two months, it is open to them to bring it to the notice of this Court by initiating a fresh contempt proceedings.

These sub-applications stand disposed of in the above terms.
