ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to grant permission to conduct cultural Programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Kuruppanaickanpalayam Village Arulmigu Sree Maha Puthu Mariyamman Temple Festival at Bhavani Taluk, Erode District on 03.03.2023, at 6.00 P.M. to 11.00 P.M, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 24.02.2023.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of Kuruppanaickanpalayam Village Arulmigu Sree Maha Puthu Mariyamman Temple Festival at Bhavani Taluk, Erode District on 03.03.2023, the petitioner has sent a representation, dated 24.02.2023 to the respondent Police.
