3. Now the petitioner/accused has taken up this petition in Crl.M.P.No.3627 of 2013 to recall the said order dated 23.02.2023, and to suspend the sentence and enlarge the petitioner on bail.

4. Today, Mr. M.Nallathambi, appointed as legal aid counsel is present. The learned counsel engaged by the appellant filed this application to suspend the sentence and recall the order dated 23.02.2023. When the learned counsel asked to argue the appeal, so that it can be disposed of, he is not ready to conduct the appeal.

5. This Court finds no genuine reason for non conducting the appeal by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/accused, even after recording his non-appearance on earlier occasion. Hence, this Court is not inclined to allow this petition and this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition in Crl.M.P.No.3627 of 2023, to recall the order dated 23.02.2023, is dismissed.
