2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that, in para 2 of the order dated 16.03.2023, inadvertently a typographical error has crept in wherein it is stated that, The Writ Petition has been filed seeking direction to the respondents to award compensation for a sum of Rs.15,00,000/- for the petitioner's injuries and Rs.30,00,000/- for the death of her mother and mother in law, which requires to be modified.

3. After perusing the order dated 16.03.2023, more specifically, para-2, this Court is satisfied and, accordingly, para-2 of the order dated 16.03.2023, would stand substituted with the following paragraph:-

“2. Since the said representation has not been considered, the present petition has been filed.”

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and having regard the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, the 4th respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioners' dated 01.02.2023 and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law,

within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
