2.The limited prayer sought for in this Writ Petition is for a direction to the fourth respondent herein to dispose of the appeal preferred by the petitioner dated 26.11.2022 within a stipulated time.

3.It is needless to point out that whenever a statutory appeal is preferred before the Appellate Authority, there is a duty cast on the respondent concerned to dispose of the appeal expeditiously. Non-compliance of such a responsibility would amount to dereliction of duties and this Court would be justified in directing the authority to dispose of the appeal within a stipulated time, in exercise of its powers under Article 226 of Constitution of India.

4. In the light of the above observations, there shall be a direction to the fourth respondent herein to dispose of the petitioner's appeal petition dated 26.11.2022, if not already disposed of, after giving due opportunity to the petitioner, as well as all the other persons who may be interested in the subject property, on its own merits and in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
