The learned Sub Judge, Rasipuram is hereby directed to issue a direction to the respondent to file counter by fixing a specific date and on such filing of the counter, the learned Sub Judge, Rasipuram, shall proceed with the enquiry after following due process and dispose of the same as expeditiously as possible.

6. Accordingly, this Civil Revision Petition is disposed of. No costs.
