This Criminal Original Petition is filed seeking bail by the 3rd accused, who is in prison for the alleged offence under Section 489 B, 489 C r/w.120B of I.P.C.,

2. Earlier, when this petitioner sought bail, this Court by an order dated 01.08.2022, dismissed the bail petition with a direction to the Trial Court to complete the trial within a period of 4 months. However, the Trial Court was not able to complete the trial within 4 months for reasons explained sought extension of time for completion of trial. Same was granted further extension of 4 months by an order dated 31.01.2023. Now, the present bail petition is filed stating that the trial has not completed within 4 months as directed by this Court vide order dated 01.08.2022. The fact that extension of 4 months time vide order dated 31.01.2023 in CrI.O.P.No.17771 of 2023 by the Hon'ble Justice T.V.Thamilselvi, has not been stated in this petition.

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3. This Court finds that the time extended after considering the fact that the accused was cause for the delay. Further as on date the time extended not expired. Hence, this bail petition is dismissed.
