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TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.79,000/- along with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum. Aggrieved by the said award amount, the Appellant/injured Claimant preferred this Appeal for enhancement and now she is attaining the age of majority.

2. During the pendency of the Appeal, the Insurance Company arrived at a settlement, thereby, the Claimant/Appellant has agreed to receive enhanced sum of Rs.50,000/- in full quit over and above awarded by the Tribunal.

3. It was agreed that the appellants/Claimants are entitled to full enhanced sum of Rs.50,000/- in addition to Rs.79,000/-, exclusively.

4. The second respondent/Insurance Company is directed to deposit the enhanced sum in full quit within a period of four weeks from today (11.02.2023).

5. On such deposit, the Appellant/Claimant is entitled to withdraw the entire enhanced amount of Rs.50,000/-. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition, if any, is closed.
