ORDER

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The Writ Petition has been filed for directing the respondent to give permission and police protection to conduct Cultural programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Erayamangalam Village Arulmigu Sree Muthu Mariyamman Temple Festival at Tiruchengode Taluk, Namakkal District on 30.03.2023 between 06.00PM to 11.00PM by considering the petitioner's representation dated 14.03.2023.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of Erayamangalam Village Arulmigu Sree Muthu Mariyamman Temple Festival at Tiruchengode Taluk, Namakkal District on 30.03.2023 between 06.00 PM to 11.00 PM, the petitioner has sent a representation dated 14.03.2023 to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.
