This Petition has been filed to condone the delay of 242 days in filing the appeal against the Judgment and decree dated 19.03.2022 passed in M.C.O.P.No.5605 of 2015 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal(II Small Causes Court) Chennai.
