This petition has been filed to condone the delay of 64 days in filing the above appeal.

2. Though notice was served to the first respondent, he has not appeared before this Court either in person or through Advocate.

4. Notice to the third respondent was dispensed with.

5. The learned counsel appearing for the second respondent fairly submits that he has no serious objection to the delay of 64 days being condoned.
