ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the first and second respondents to grant permission to conduct the cultural programme of Adal Padal on 14.04.2023 at 06.00 PM to 11.00 PM at "Sri Mariamman Temple festival" Veppilaipatti Village, Ketturedippatti Post, Pappireddipatti Taluk, Dharmapuri District by considering the petitioner's representation dated 17.03.2023.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of "Sri Mariamman Temple festival" Veppilaipatti Village, Ketturedippatti Post, Pappireddipatti Taluk, Dharmapuri District on 14.04.2023 between 06.00 PM to 11.00 PM, the petitioner has sent a representation dated 17.03.2023 to the second respondent police. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondents submitted that the second respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a Circular Memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the second respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 17.03.2023 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.
