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ORDER

This Writ petition has been filed seeking direction to the 1st respondent to release the 251.50 Quintals of rice seized by the 2nd respondent on 10.09.2022.

2. Mr.M.Alagu Goutham, learned Government Advocate takes notice for the respondents. In view of the consent expressed by the Learned counsel appearing for either side, this petition is taken up for final disposal.

3. The case of the petitioner is that the petitioner/industry is a Whole Sale Dealer in Rice Business at Adasapur, Odisha. As the petitioner received orders from another Trader namely, V.M.Traders, Nemmara, Kerala, for selling rice bags, the petitioner/industry sold 251.50 quintals of boiled rice under cover of Birla Supply on 05.09.2022 and the same was transported through Lorry bearing Registration No.TN-40-Q-1776. While so, the 2nd respondent seized the rice bags and the above said lorry on its way, inspite of the fact that the petitioner's driver produced the necessary bill of supply. Therefore, the petitioner made a representation dated 28.02.2023 before the 1st respondent, seeking to release the seized 251.50 Quintals of rice to the petitioner/industry, however, till date, no orders have been passed on the



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the view that, no further adjudication is necessary in this Writ petition and the prayer sought for by the petitioner in this petition cannot be acceded to.

However, the respondents are directed to furnish the said Quality certificate to the petitioner, enabling the petitioner to workout the remedy in the manner known to law.

7. For the reasons aforesaid, this Writ petition stands dismissed. No costs.
