The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to give permission and police protection to conduct cultural programme of (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Kondakinthanapalli, Thangamalai Adivaram Village, Arulmigu Sri Chendryaya Swamy Temple Anna Patchi Urchavam, Simha Vagan Urchavam and Anumanththa Vahana Urchavaam Festival at Natrampalli Takuk, Tirupattur District on 02.04.2023, 03.04.2023 and 04.04.2023 between 06:00 pm to 11:00 pm by considering the petitioner's representation dated 06.03.2023.
