ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to give permission and police protection to conduct cultural programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Kondakinthanapalli, Thangamalai Adivaram Village, Arulmigu Sri Chendryaya Swamy Temple Radha Urchavam, Kudhirai Vaganam Urchavam, and Pushpa Pallakku Urchavam Festival at Natrampalli Taluk, Tirupattur District 05.04.2023, 06.04.2023 and 07.04.2023 between 06.00 P.M to 11.00 P.M by considering petitioner representation dated 06.03.2023.

dated 06.03.2023 to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

4. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a Circular Memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation
