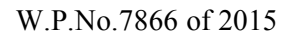

This writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to take into account the services of the petitioner from 03.02.1984 to 20.12.1989 as Section Writer on daily wage basis and from 21.12.1989 to 21.11.1995 as Field Surveyor in Survey and Land Records Department on consolidated monthly basis along with the regular service in the Revenue Department from 22.11.1995 to 31.12.2014 to reckon the total qualifying service for pension, and to consequently revise the retirement and pensionary benefits.



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2. The learned counsel appearing for the sixth respondent would submit that subsequent to filing of the writ petition, the request of the petitioner was considered and 50% of the qualifying service was included for the purpose of pensionary benefits and accordingly, proceedings were issued.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the sixth respondent has also filed a copy of the authorization given to the Accountant General Office.

4. Since the purpose has already been fulfilled by including the petitioner's 50% of qualifying service while calculating his pension, further order cannot be passed as the writ petition has become infructuous.

Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed as having become infructuous. No costs.
