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ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed directing the respondent herein to consider the petitioner's representation dated 18.03.2023 and permit the petitioner to conduct the cultural program in the open space (thidal) of Sri Kalamman Temple, Valiammal Colony, Kanakapalayam Village, Udumalpettai Taluk, Tiruppur District from 8 pm onwards 14.04.2023.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of Sri Kalamman Temple, Valiammal Colony, Kanakapalayam Village, Udumalpettai Taluk, Tiruppur District on 14.04.2023 between 06.00 PM to 11.00 PM, the petitioner has sent a representation dated 18.03.2023 to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

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the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a Circular Memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 18.03.2023 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
