ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to grant permission to conduct cultural Programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Sri Shakthi Maariyamman Temple situated at Pudhupettai Colony, Vanavasi, Salem, Tamil Nadu – 636 457, on 07.04.2023, at 6.00 P.M. to 11.00 P.M, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 29.03.2023.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of Sri Shakthi Maariyamman Temple situated at Pudhupettai Colony, Vanavasi, Salem, Tamil Nadu – 636 457, on 07.04.2023, the petitioner has sent a representation, dated 29.03.2023 to the respondent Police. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.
