ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent authority to give permission to conduct the dance program (Aadal Paadal) at place of the Nallagoundenpalayam Village Arulmigu Sri Madurai Veeran Kovil Thiruvizha on 06.04.2023 and subsequently the petitioner representation dated 31.03.2023 at Kumilanparappu Colony, Nallagoundenpalayam Village, Chithode, Erode District.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of *Arulmigu Sri Madurai Veeran Kovil Thiruvizha Kumilanparappu Colony, Nallagoundenpalayam Village, Chithode, Erode District on 06.04.2023, the petitioner has sent a representation dated 31.03.2023* to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.



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3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

4. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a Circular Memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated **31.03.2023** and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.
