This petition is filed to grant leave to prefer an appeal against the judgment dated 09.03.2023 made in C.C.No.71 of 2019 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court, Magisterial level, Alandur, Chengalpattu District.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that though the accused did not specifically deny his signature on the cheque, the trial Court acquitted him by shifting the entire burden upon the complainant.
