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TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal had been filed by the Appellant/Transport Corporation aggrieved by the award of the Tribunal granting a sum of Rs.6,60,000/- (Rupees Six Lakh Sixty Thousand only). The Appellant/Transport Corporation had already deposited Rs.4,43,047/- (Rupees Four Lakh Fourty Three Thousand Fourty Seven only). The Appellant/Transport Corporation entered into an agreement with the Respondents 1 and 2/Claimants whereby, the Appellant/Transport Corporation is agreed to deposit the balance amount of Rs.3,46,953/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Fourty Six Thousand Nine Fifty Three only), in full quit, which was agreed by the respondents 1 and 2.

2. It was agreed that the Respondents 1 and 2/Claimants are entitled to receive the sum of Rs.7,90,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Ninety Thousand only) in full quit.

3. The Appellant/Transport Corporation is directed to deposit the agreed amount within a period of 8 weeks from today.

4. On such deposit, the Respondents 1 and 2 are entitled to withdraw the amount deposited as apportioned by the Tribunal.



Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition, if any, is closed.
