This petition has been filed to condone the delay of 132 days in filing the C.M.A.Sr.No.53670 of 2023.

2.It is submitted by the learned counsel for the appellant that the first respondent remained ex-parte before the Tribunal and so notice to the first respondent may be dispensed with and he has also made an endorsement to that effect in the grounds of appeal. Hence, notice to the first respondent is dispensed with.
