When the matter came up for hearing today, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and the learned Standing counsel appearing on behalf of Chennai Corporation submitted that the meetings were held and ultimately, in the meeting that was held on 01.06.2023, an understanding was arrived at and the petitioner will proceed further in accordance with the understanding reached with Chennai Corporation.



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4. Recording the above submission, this Writ petition is closed. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
