ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to forthwith give necessary police protection to the petitioner to conduct the "Chithirai Palkudam Festival" at Arulmighu Sri Thanthondriya Samayapuram Muthu Mariamman, Sri Ellai Amman and Sri Sandhi Angali Amman Temple at Tiruneermalai Road, Nagalkeni, Chennai - 600 044 on 05.05.2023 by considering and passing necessary orders on the representation of the petitioner dated 24.04.2023.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of ***"Chithirai Palkudam Festival" at Arulmighu Sri Thanthondriya Samayapuram Muthu Mariamman, Sri Ellai Amman and Sri Sandhi Angali Amman Temple at Tiruneermalai Road, Nagalkeni, Chennai - 600 044 on 05.05.2023, the petitioner has sent a representation dated 24.04.2023*** to

the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the

present writ petition has been filed.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

4. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a Circular Memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated **24.04.2023** and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.
