This case came up for settlement before the National Lok Adalat. Both the parties are present. The learned counsel for the appellant Mrs.Ramya V.Rao and the learned counsel for the respondents Mr.C.Ramesh Babu is present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties,

they arrived at a compromise to settle the matter as follows:



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TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

Both the parties and their respective counsel are present.

2. The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.13,60,200/-(Rupees Thirteen Lakhs Sixty Thousand and Two Hundred only) with interest at 7.5% p.a. from the date of petition till the date of deposit as compensation.

3. Aggrieved by the award, the appellants/claimants have preferred the present appeal. Now the appellants/claimants have agreed to receive a sum of Rs.9,00,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs only) in addition to the amount awarded by the Tribunal in full quit, which is also acceptable by the 2nd respondent/New India Assurance Company Limited.

4. The 2nd respondent/New India Assurance Company Limited is directed to deposit the award amount, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. Award is passed accordingly.

5. The Tribunal is directed to issue the award amount through NEFT/RTGS to the party concerned on proper identification in accordance with the terms of the award, without insisting on any formal permission petition.

6. The appeal is ordered accordingly. Consequently, the connected MP, if any, is closed.
