The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471 & 506(ii) of I.P.C, in Crime number 13 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. There are totally three accused involved in this case and the petitioner is arrayed as A1. The case of the prosecution as per the *de facto* complainant is that the petitioner along with other accused have cheated the *de facto* complainant by obtaining payment of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees ten lakhs only) on false promise and assurance on getting job for her daughter in Chennai Corporation. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
