**PRAYER :** The Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondent to give permission to conduct cultural programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Pudupettai Village Arulmigu Sree Mariyamman Temple Festival at Palakkodu Taluk, Dharmapuri District on 25.05.2023 between 06.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. by considering the petitioner's representation dated 02.05.2023.

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**ORDER**



The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to grant permission to conduct cultural programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Pudupettai Village Arulmigu Sree Mariyamman Temple Festival at Palakkodu Taluk, Dharmapuri District scheduled to be held on 25.05.2023 between 06.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. by considering the petitioner's representation dated 02.05.2023.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme on 25.05.2023 between 06.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. in Pudupettai Village Arulmigu Sree Mariyamman Temple Festival at Palakkodu Taluk, Dharmapuri District, the petitioner has sent a representation dated 02.05.2023 to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a Circular Memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 02.05.2023 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is allowed. No costs.
