ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the first and second respondents to grant permission to conduct the cultural programme of Adal Padal on 26.05.2023 at 06.00 PM to 11.00 PM at "Sri Gengaiamman Temple festival" Anna Nagar, Periyavarikam Village, Thuthipattu Post, Ambur Taluk, Tiruppattur District by consider and pass orders on the representation dated 29.04.2023 made by the petitioner within the time frame as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of " Sri Gengaiamman Temple festival" Anna Nagar, Periyavarikam Village, Thuthipattu Post, Ambur Taluk, Tiruppattur District on 26.05.2023 at 06.00 PM to 11.00 PM, the petitioner has sent a representation dated 29.04.2023 to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ



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petition has been filed.

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3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondents submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

4. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police.

5. It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a Circular Memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 29.04.2023 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.
