ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the first and second respondents to grant permission to conduct the cultural programme of Adal Padal on 22.05.2023 at 06.00 P.M to 11.00 P.M at “Sri Maha Mariamman & Sri Maha Kaliamman Temple festival” Kadathur Village, Kadathur Post, Pappireddipatti Taluk, Dharmapuri District by considering the petitioner's representation dated 22.04.2023 and pass orders on the same, within the time frame as may be fixed by this Court.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of ***Sri Maha Mariamman & Sri Maha Kaliamman Temple Festival at Kadathur Village, Kadathur Post, Pappireddipatti Taluk, Dharmapuri District on 22.05.2023 between 06.00 P.M to 11.00 P.M, the petitioner has sent a***



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representation dated 22.04.2023 to the respondents. But, the same has not

been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondents submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

4. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondents.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a Circular Memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondents are hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 22.04.2023 and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.
