ORDER

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This Writ Petition has been filed to the respondent to grant permission and police protection to conduct Cultural Programme (Adal Padal Nigalchi) in the event of Arkattan Kudisai Village, Bajanai Kovil Street Arulmigu Sree Mechiyamman Temple Festival at Vellore Taluk and District on 08.06.2023 between 06.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m. by considering the petitioner's representation dated 25.05.2023.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that in order to conduct the cultural programme in the event of *Arkattan Kudisai Village, Bajanai Kovil Street Arulmigu Sree Mechiyamman Temple Festival at Vellore Taluk and District on 08.06.2023 between 06.00 p.m. and 11.00 p.m., the petitioner has sent a representation dated 25.05.2023* to the respondent. But, the same has not been considered so far. Hence, the present writ petition has been filed.

3. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.

4. I have considered the submission of the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police.

It is brought to the notice of this Court that the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu, Chennai, had issued a Circular Memorandum in Rc.007301/Genl.I(1)/2019, dated 09.04.2019, along with instructions to the Inspectors of Police throughout Tamil Nadu for consideration of applications seeking permission for conducting cultural programme. Therefore, in view of the detailed circular and guidelines issued by the Director General of Police, the respondent police is hereby directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated **25.05.2023** and pass suitable orders based on the above said circular.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
