It is needless to state that if there is any further interference with reference to the petitioners' peaceful possession of the suit schedule property till such time as the injunction order passed in CMP.No.9386 of 2021 is in force, the petitioners are given liberty to get necessary police protection to protect their possession.



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3. The contempt petition is therefore closed. The contemnors are present before this Court today as well. No costs.
