These applications are filed to condone the delay of 602 days in filing the petition to set aside the abatement caused due to the death of the 1st defendant; to set aside abatement caused due to the death of the 1st defendant; and to bring on record the respondents 2 to 4 being the legal heirs of the deceased 1st defendant as defendants 3 to 5 in C.S.No.68 of 2020.

2. The learned counsel for the applicant would submit that despite the legal heirs of the deceased 1st defendant stood as parties (plaintiffs 2 to 4) in the connected T.O.S.No.31 of 2017, the death of the 1st defendant was not brought to his notice. Hence, there was a delay in filing these applications.



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3. Sufficient reasons have been given in the affidavit filed in support of these applications. Therefore, these applications are allowed.
