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ORDER

The Writ Petition has been filed for directing the 1st respondent to issue a No objection Certificate to the petitioner to run a SPA i.e. cross relaxation massage in the name and style of “M/s.LE POSH AYURVEDI and BEAUTY'S” SPA at Door No. 200, Plot No. 47, College road, Tirupur, Tirupur District, Pin 641 602, by passing orders on the petitioners representation dated 30.05.2023.

2. It is the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is running a SPA i.e., cross relaxation massage in the name and style of “M/s.LE POSH AYURVEDI and BEAUTY'S” SPA at Door No. 200, Plot No. 47, College road, Tirupur, Tirupur District, Pin 641 602. He would further submit that the petitioner has made a representation dated 30.05.2023 to the respondents seeking for the issuance of “No Objection Certificate” to run the said business and the same is not considered by the respondents. Hence the petition.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), appearing for the respondents submitted that the respondent police has received the representation of the petitioner and the same is pending for consideration.



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4. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondents police.

5. Considering the above, this Court directs the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation dated 30.05.2023 with regard to the issuance of "No Objection Certificate" and decide the same within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order in accordance with law.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed. No costs.
