TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

This Civil Miscellaneous Appeal had been filed by the
Appellant/Insurance Company aggrieved by the award of a sum of



Rs.3,85,900/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Eighty Five Thousand and Nine Hundred Only) as compensation for the injuries suffered by the first Respondent/Claimant along with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum.

2.The Appellant/Insurance Company entered into an agreement whereby the first Respondent/Claimant agreed to receive a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs and Fifty Thousand Only) with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of claim petition.

3. It was agreed that the first Respondent/Claimant is entitled to receive a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs and Fifty Thousand Only) with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of claim petition.

4. The Appellant/Insurance Company had already deposited 50% of the award amount, hence, the Appellant/Insurance Company is directed to deposit the balance amount agreed now with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of Claim Petition, within a period of eight weeks from today.

5. On such deposit, the first respondent/claimant is entitled to withdraw the entire amount. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition, if any, is closed.
